Name of Highway: **Central Street**

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Saugus

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

**CENTRAL STREET - NORTHBOUND**

Beginning at Lincoln Avenue thence northerly on Central Street

0.26	miles	at	30	miles	per	hour	
0.30	"	"	35	"	"	"	
0.20	"	"	30	"	"	"	
0.44	"	"	25	"	"	"	
0.33	"	"	20	"	"	"	
0.23	"	"	25	"	"	"	
0.43	"	"	35	"	"	"	
0.29	"	"	30	"	"	"	ending at Walnut Street.

The total distance being 2.48 miles.

**CENTRAL STREET - SOUTHBOUND**

Beginning at a point 100 feet south of Central Street thence southerly

0.27	miles	at	30	miles	per	hour	
0.43	"	"	35	"	"	"	
0.23	"	"	25	"	"	"	
0.33	"	"	20	"	"	"	
0.44	"	"	25	"	"	"	
0.20	"	"	30	"	"	"	
0.30	"	"	35	"	"	"	
0.26	"	"	30	"	"	"	ending at Lincoln Avenue.

The total distance being 2.46 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
