In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Canton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

York Street - NORTHEBOUND

Beginning at the Stoughton town line,
Thence northerly on York Street

0.36 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.49	"	"	30	"	"	"
1.07	"	"	25	"	"	"
0.23	"	"	30	"	"	"
0.12	"	"	25	"	"	"

the total distance being 2.27 miles.

ending at Randolph Street,

York Street - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Randolph Street,
Thence southerly on York Street,

0.12 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.23	"	"	30	"	"	"
1.07	"	"	25	"	"	"
0.49	"	"	30	"	"	"
0.36	"	"	25	"	"	"

the total distance being 2.27 miles.

ending at the Stoughton

town line, the total distance being 2.27 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.)
