hereby Adopted

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described: no charge recently should no

Main Street (Route 123) - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Hanover-Norwell line, thence easterly on Main Street (Route 123)

1.09 miles at 45 miles per hour

" " ending at the Norwell-1.44 " 40 Scituate line; the total distance being 4.93 miles.

Main Street (Route 123) - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Scituate-Norwell line, thence westerly on Main Street (Route 123)

1.45 miles at 40 miles per hour

" 30-4" 0.67

1.72 40

1.09 45 11 " ending at the Norwell-11 Hanover line; the total distance being 4.93 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
