SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION # 7682

Highway Location: NORTHFIELD
Authority In Control: TOWN OF NORTHFIELD
Name of Highway (s): SOUTH MOUNTAIN ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

Hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Northfield

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTH MOUNTAIN ROAD - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Route 63, thence easterly on South Mountain Road;
1.30 miles at 25 miles per hour
2.38 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at the junction of Gulf Road; the total distance being 3.68 miles.

SOUTH MOUNTAIN ROAD - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Gulf Road, thence westerly on South Mountain Road;
2.38 miles at 30 miles per hour
1.30 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Route 63; the total distance being 3.68 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
