Highway Location: PELHAM
Authority In Control: TOWN OF PELHAM
Name of Highway: HARKNESS ROAD

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Pelham

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

HARKNESS ROAD-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 150 feet north of Route 9, thence northerly on Harkness Road:

0.83 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.71 " " 30 " " "
0.16 " " 25 " " " ending at Amherst Road,

the total distance being 1.70 miles.

HARKNESS ROAD-SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Amherst Road, thence southerly on Harkness Road

0.16 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.71 " " 30 " " "
0.77 " " 40 " " "
0.09 " " 25 " " " ending at Route 9, the

total distance being 1.73 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
